# CHILD/YOUTH FAITH FORMATION SESSIONS

### 1. Children's Liturgy of the Word (ages 4-9)

Sunday mornings, during the 11:00 am Mass, beginning in September 2018

All young children attending this Sunday morning Mass are invited to hear and reflect on the Word of God in their own special way. A catechist will lead the children to the Chapel after the Opening Prayer. Together they will reflect on the readings of the day through example and story. Children will naturally learn to participate by sharing such as: Who was in the story? or What did you hear? Children will again join their families in the church after the petitions. This is meant to be an age appropriate prayer experience for young children in kindergarten through third grade. There is no fee and no registration for Children's Liturgy of the Word.

#### 2. Elementary Program (Grades 1-5)

Wednesday evenings, 6:30-7:40 pm, beginning September 12, 2018

Nativity Church and school classrooms

The most important contribution of parents to the faith formation of their children lies in their Christian witness. The Faith Formation process at Nativity believes strongly in Parent Partnership. Parents begin each session in song, Scripture and prayer with their child in the worship space of the church.

### 3. Youth Ministry — W.O.W. (Grades 6-8)

This is an opportunity for youth to gather together with friends to talk about how Christ might expect them to respond to their life situations. ## 4. Youth Ministry—LinC (Grades 9-12)

Wednesday evenings, 7:45-9:15 pm, beginning September 12, 2018 Nativity Youth Room

"LinC; Life in Christ" is designed to focus on relationships of family, friends, and faith. LinC is not an activity or a youth night. LinC is a family, with each member playing an important role in the family. It is not just a night to go to; it is a group to belong to. LinC attempts to bring teens to full, conscious, and active participation in their church though ministry, service and outreach, and living the Gospel.
