CHILD/YOUTH FAITH FORMATION SESSIONS

1. Children's Liturgy of the Word (ages 4-9)

Sunday mornings; beginning date to be announced.

All young children attending this Sunday morning Mass are invited to hear and reflect on the Word of God in their own special way. A catechist will lead the children to the Chapel after the Opening Prayer. Together they will reflect on the readings of the day through example and story. Children will naturally learn to participate by sharing such as: Who was in the story? or What did you hear? Children will again join their families in the church after the petitions. This is meant to be an age appropriate prayer experience for young children in kindergarten through third grade. **There is no fee and no registration for Children's Liturgy of the Word.**

2. Elementary Program (Grades 1-5)
