CHILD/YOUTH SACRAMENTS

Our diocesan guidelines stress that parents who choose to prepare their children for sacraments should become involved in the child's preparation through prayer in the home, regular experiences of Sunday Mass and attendance at parent sessions and retreats for each of these sacraments.

First Reconciliation (Penance): Grade 2 and above

Parents and Parish work together. Regular attendance and active participation in Faith Formation or JP II school program is required for the reception of First Reconciliation which typically takes place in the second grade and above. In addition to the preparation booklet, Encounter with Christ, parents and children in both catholic schools and Faith Formation attend a sacramental retreat at Nativity Church. The celebration of First Reconciliation usually takes place during the Easter season.

Confirmation and First Eucharist: Grade 3 and above

Parents and parish work together. Regular attendance and active participation in Faith Formation or JP II school program is required for the reception of Confirmation and First Eucharist. All third grade children and above, preparing to receive Confirmation and First Eucharist, must also have been prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In addition to the preparation booklet, Encounter with Christ, each sacrament has a parent/child retreat planned at Nativity Church. The celebration of both sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist usually takes place during the Easter season with Bishop John Folda.
